

PMAC Committee & Networking Groups Overview

This document outlines the committees and networking groups that are available to PMAC members. Please note that these meetings are all available by teleconference. Attendance to these meetings is not mandatory but members are encouraged to participate and contribute when able to.

Canadian Institutional Client Service Network (CICSN)

Purpose: A forum to discuss significant issues and trends specific to institutional client service member firms, as well as to grow and nurture a network of like-minded institutional client service colleagues for the betterment of the industry. Meets quarterly.

Mandate:

• A platform for Canadian Institutional Client Service Professionals to network and discuss local global trends including issues impacting their key functions while onboarding, retaining, and terminating clients.

Requirements:

- Active managers
- Global firm with Canadian presence
- \$20 \$50 billion AUM in Canada
- Limited to Institutional business with similar strategies (public equities and fixed income)

Compliance Officers' Network (CON)

Purpose: Member-driven forum for open discussion of compliance issues/share and develop guidelines for members. Meets 5 times a year, hosted at one of PMAC's affiliate law firms.

Mandate:

- To provide Members with a forum for the exchange of information in which compliance issues may be discussed by peers and in which guidelines for Members may be developed.
- To consider all matters with respect to compliance with securities, tax laws and other applicable regulations and to provide Member firms with any information that would be of assistance to them in the performance of compliance obligations.

Requirements:

- Restricted to PMAC members only
- Open to all members, CCOs, legal and other compliance professionals

Emerging Trends Committee

Purpose: Meets on ad hoc basis to address current member concerns and to remain abreast of significant issues and trends impacting firms as well as the Association.

Mandate:

- Acts as a supporting group to other PMAC groups and committees to ensure that they are implementing services aligned with emerging trends
- Monitors emerging industry trends, issues and the resulting impact on PMAC, its members and other constituents

Industry, Regulation & Tax Committee (IRT)

- To monitor securities, pension and tax regulation and respond to relevant issues and regulatory proposals that impact Members.
- To initiate issues for beneficial change by maintaining communication with governments and elected representatives.
- To monitor and provide Members with regular updates on international developments impacting Canadian portfolio managers, and where appropriate, advocating on behalf of Members.
